Greetings from the Forest of Tarumitra in Bihar, India.

We have just returned from the ART RESIDENCY in Wagamon Kerala where 20 artists congregated in the mountains for ten days and connected Art to the Earth. Wonderful days they were!

Kindly look at the creativity shown by the Indian Jesuits in applying Pope Francis' Lautado Si into daily life of students, eco-enthusiasts both old and young.

These workshops and camps were spiced with 8-day Eco-retreats mainly in Gujarat, Western India and Bihar in Eastern India. While Gujarat had five Eco-retreats staffed by Rappai SJ and Lancy D'Cruze Sj, Robert Athickal SJ and team organized eight Retreats across the country from Tarumitra, Patna.

Tarumitra Co-ordiantor Devopriya, Siddharth a classs IX student from St. Michael's and Fr. Robert visited Rome in connection with Laudato Si and met over 500

delegates along with Pope Francis!



Devopriya still says that meeting the Pope was the most unforgettable event of the Roman Days.

The Summer camps were getting organized faster than ever. The Co-ordinator Devopriya and Maggi found themselves fully engaged to organize these memorable camps for students who came from different parts of the country.

One of the regular shows at these camps was the screening of Journey of the Universe a film by Brian Swimme and Prof. Mary Evelyn Tucker. The film and disscussions stayed on with the participants for long.

Dr. Orla Hazra who visited us on and off added more spice by initiating one of the volunteers Nagesh Anand into organizing the Cosmic Walk Meditation every Satuday evenings. Hundreds of people have already participated in this heart-changing meditation process.








Ramesh is sure to get the plantations under way by the monsoon 2019. He has a plan to do Masters in theology from Delhi starting this year.

The Hazaribagh Jesuits have asked us to help them to set up a larger Bioreserve like the one in Patna in the spacious 100 acre campus in Sitagraha in Hazaribagh. The students of St. Xavier's high school Hazaribagh have taken up the task under the leadership of Zamir sir.



The Hazaribagh Jesuits have also asked us to help to set up yet another Bio-reserve in the 25 acre campus of St. Xavier's college in Mahuadanr. The students of the college along with the Principal Fr M.K Jose SJ are fully into this pioneering eco-task at the moment.

Last not but not the least, Fr. Robert Athickal SJ got his transfer from the Tarumitra Ashram. His provincial asked him to take a three month Sabbatical from the 20 year old assignment at the Ashram. Fr. Tony Penda SJ, a veteran social activist has taken over as the new director. Life is going on at the Ashram as if nothing big happened!

Fr.
